

TABLE TENNIS

All matches for singles, doubles, and mixed doubles will follow the International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF) regulations. ITTF website 2021ITTFHandbook.pdf (Section 3, Page 39 to 59). These rules ensure consistent play, fair competition, and safety across all divisions.

Tournament Format

Events Offered

- Men's Singles
- Women's Singles
- Men's Doubles
- Women's Doubles
- Mixed Doubles

Categories:

- Class A, Class B, Class C
- (Players will be grouped by skill level or prior ranking)

Match Format:

- Matches will be played as best of 5 or best of 7 games
- Each game is played to 11 points
- A player must win by a minimum margin of 2 points
- Rally point scoring applies (every rally result in a point)

Singles Rules

- Players alternate serving every 2 points; at 10–10, serve alternates every point
- Serve must be tossed at least 16 cm vertically, struck behind the end line, and land legally on the opponent's side
- Players switch ends after each game, and during the final game when one player reaches 5 points
- The expedite system activates if a game exceeds 10 minutes and fewer than 18 points are scored
- Players may not touch the table, volley, or obstruct play
- Unsportsmanlike conduct is penalized by yellow or red cards



TABLE TENNIS

Doubles Rules

- Each team has two players, who must alternate hits during rallies
- Serve must be diagonal, from the server's right side to the opponent's right side
- Teams alternate serves every 2 points; after 10–10, serve alternates each point
- · Partners must maintain the order of play throughout the match
- Teams change ends after each game, and again at 5 points during the final game
- Violations such as incorrect order, improper serve, or touching the table result in point loss

Mixed Doubles Rules

- Teams consist of one male and one female player
- Play follows standard doubles format with alternating shots between partners
- Service and return sequences must alternate between genders throughout the match
- · All serving must be done diagonally and in the correct rotation

Equipment Standards

- Ball: 40mm, plastic, white or orange
- Racket: Must have one red and one black rubber side
- Table: 2.74m (L) × 1.525m (W) × 76cm (H)
- Net height: 15.25cm
- Players must wear ITTF-approved sportswear with non-marking shoes

Conduct and Etiquette

- Only team captains may raise disputes with officials
- No loud shouting or distracting gestures during matches
- The referee's decisions are final
- Any misconduct may lead to point deductions, disqualification, or bans

Awards (Per Class, Per Event):

- 1st Place: Trophy + Gold Medal
- 2nd Place: Trophy + Silver Medal
- 3rd Place: Trophy + Bronze Medal

Total Prizes:

- 15 Trophies each for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places (45 total)
- 45 Medals in total (Gold, Silver, Bronze)
